

CRAFT PROJECT



MAKE YOUR OWN SUN CATCHER!

With household items you have around the house you can make your very own sun catcher! It' easy! All you need is:


Coloring pages, or one of the templates from here, printed on basic printer paper Mason jar lids - wide mouth or regular - the examples in the photo are of each kind. Cooking oil (olive oil, canola oil, etc.)
Twine, string or yarn
Cotton balls or Q-tips
Watercolors, markers, or colored pencils
Coloring pages or your own design or you can use the templates here
Tea towel or newspaper to protect the surface
Glue (but not a glue stick)


Steps:

- If you don't have any coloring books/pages and you don't want to use one of the templates here, or you
 don't; want to come up with your own design, you can go to www.100directions.com and choose from a
 ton of free printable coloring pages! and this website is where this craft project originally comes from!
- 2. Prior to coloring, make a copy of it on printer paper or you can use one of templates which is already on printer paper.
- 3. Color your copied piece of art (if using one of the templates, color it anyway you like). Allow for drying time if using watercolors.


- 4. Once your piece is dry, choose which area you would like to frame with the mason jar lid and trace the area with it.
- 5. Coat the area with cooking oil using a cotton ball or Q-tip. You don't want to drench it but you do want to make sure it is completely covered. Dab any excess oil off and watch the magic happen! The oil makes it more translucent! Allow to dry for approximately 5 minutes.
- 6. Cut out your circle but cut it on the inside so it fits inside the lid.
- 7. Put some glue on the inside of the lid and place your art in lid facing outward. Allow to dry.
- 8. Tie your twine, string, or yarn around the outside of your lid, and make sure to leave at least 4 inches so you can hang your sun catcher.


Voila, you have your very own sun catcher


